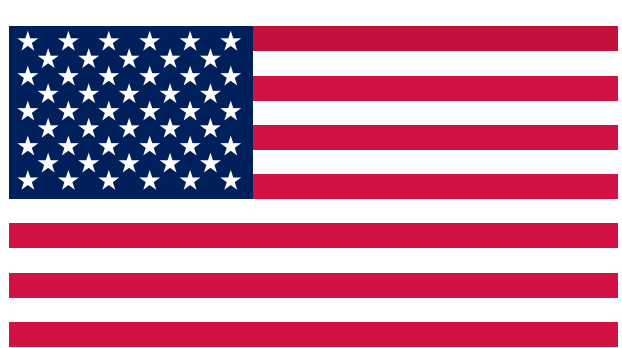

Overview

The TWS3 earbuds feature advanced Bluetooth® technology for seamless wireless connectivity, touch controls for easy operation, and a compact charging case for on-the-go power. Key features include:

Audio Quality: Crystal-clear sound with deep bass and balanced highs.

Noise Management: Active Noise Cancellation (ANC) to block out external noise, Transparency mode to stay aware of your surroundings, and Environmental Noise Cancellation (ENC) for clearer calls.

Battery Life: Up to 5 hours of playback on a single charge (with ANC off), extendable to 24 hours with the charging case.

Connectivity: Bluetooth 5.3 for stable pairing with smartphones, tablets, and other devices.

Design: Ergonomic fit with IPX4 water resistance for sweat and rain protection.

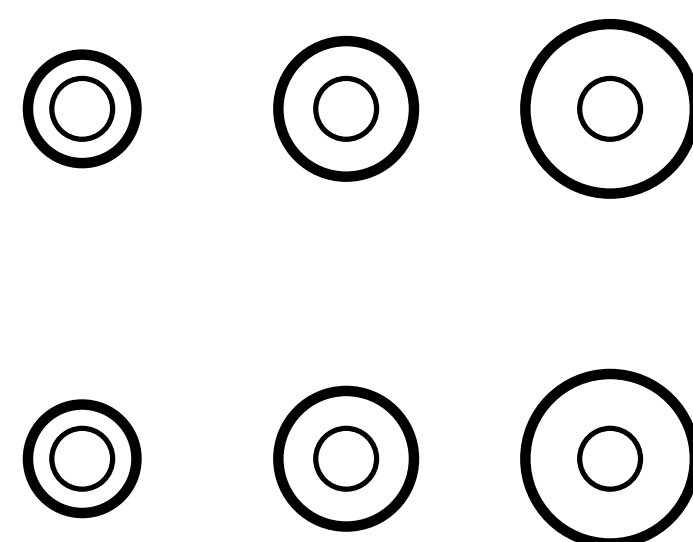

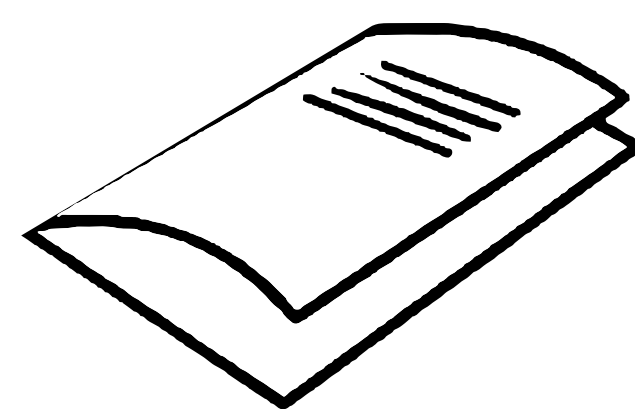

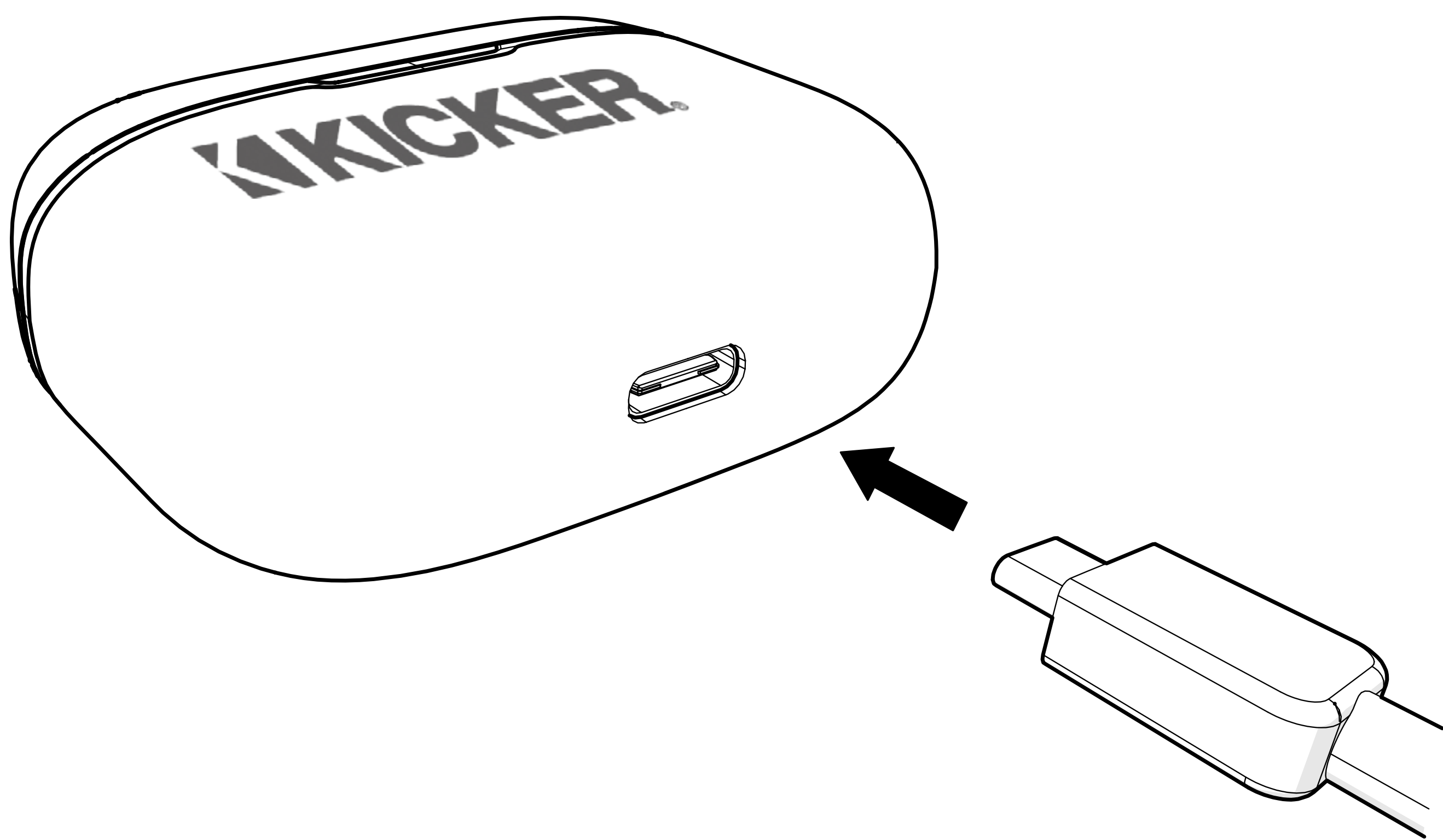
Charging

Proper charging ensures optimal performance and longevity of your earbuds. Charge the case fully before first use.

Charging the Case

Connect the included USB-C cable to the charging port on the bottom of the case.

Plug the other end into a compatible 5V power source (e.g., a wall adapter, computer USB port, or power bank).



During Charging: The red light on the charging case will flash, showing that the case is receiving power.

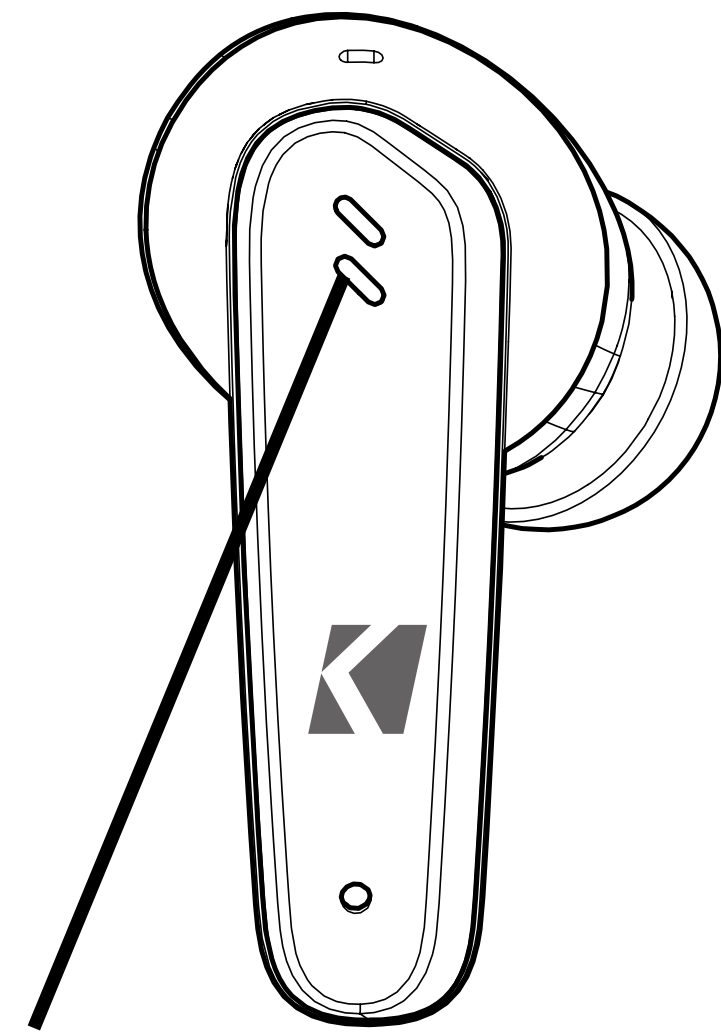
Fully Charged: The red light will remain on, indicating the case is fully charged and ready for use.

Avoid extreme temperatures during charging (ideal range: 0°C to 45°C or 32°F to 113°F). If the case battery is low, it may take up to 2 hours to fully charge.

Charging the Earbuds

If the battery is low, the Status LED will slowly blink red.

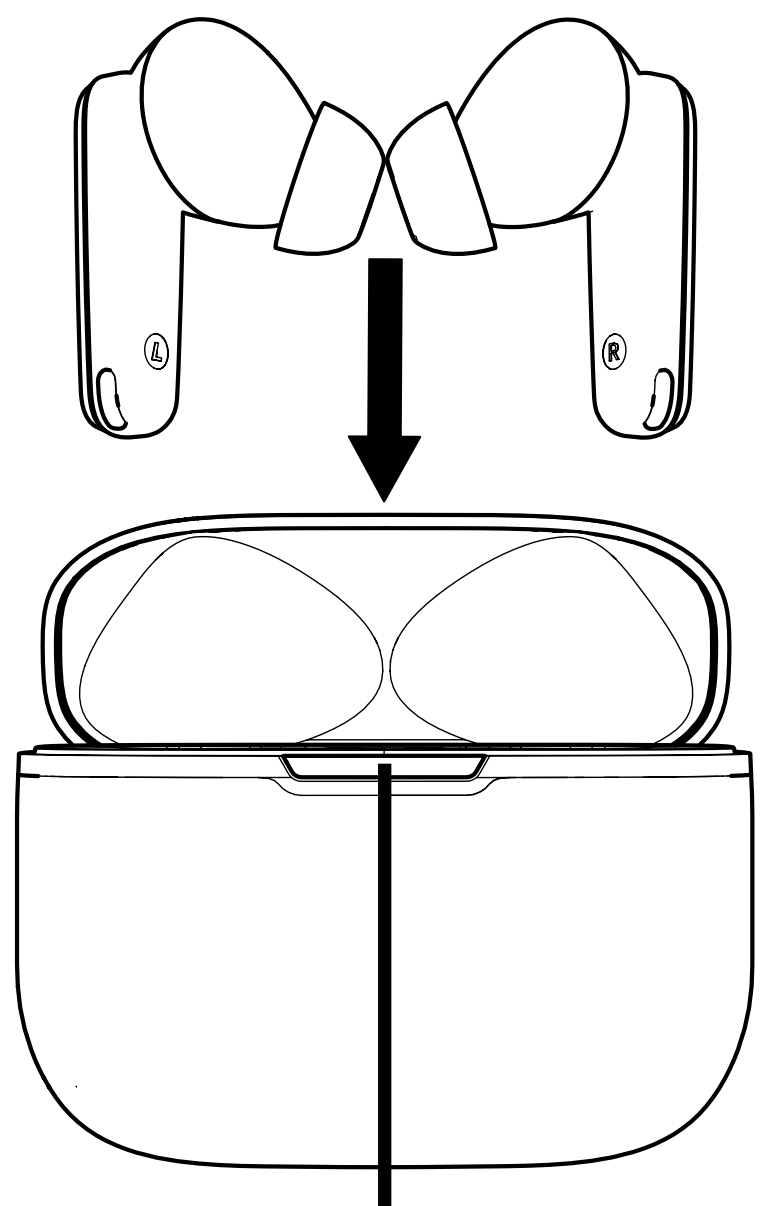
Place the earbuds into the Charging Case, ensuring they are oriented and seated correctly.



Battery Status Light

Close the case lid. The earbuds will automatically begin charging if the case has sufficient power.

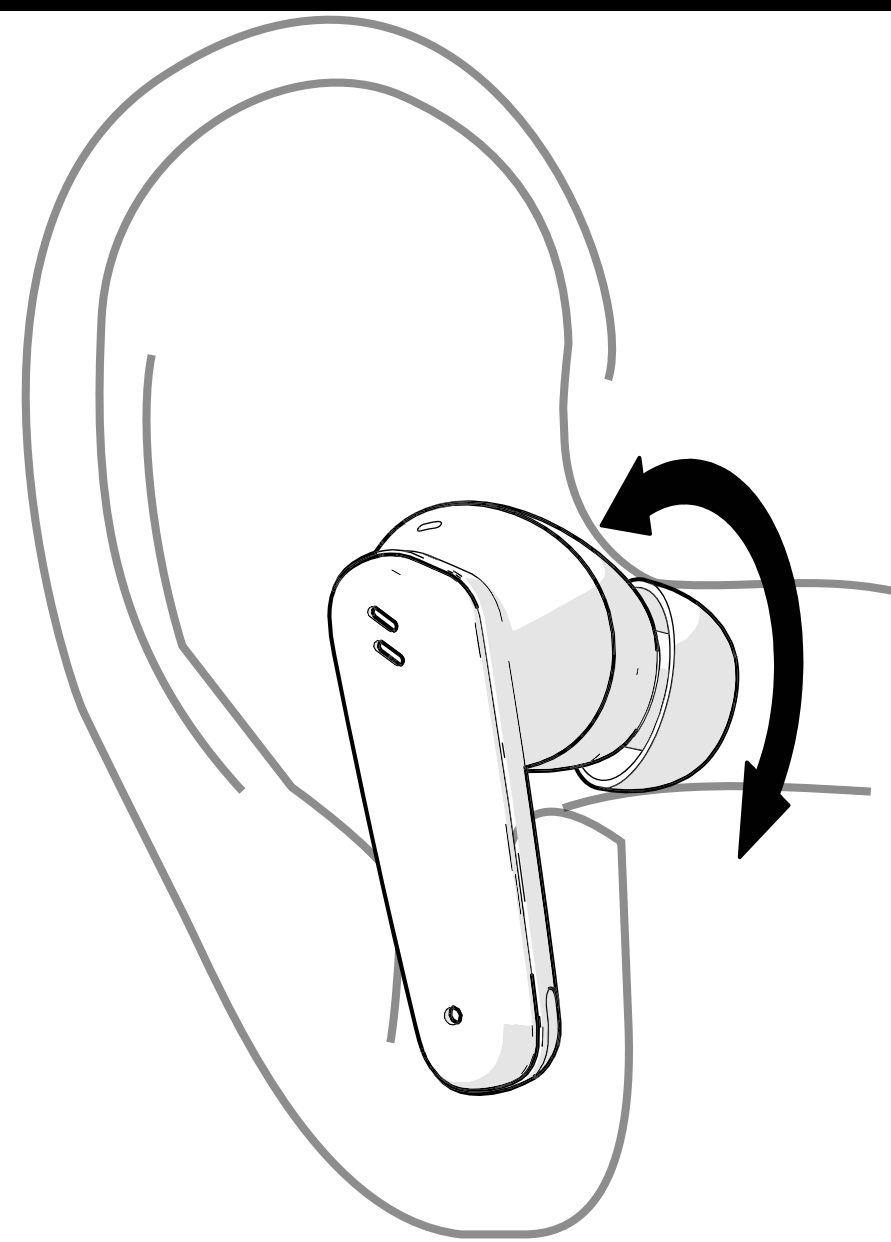
Note: Always use the provided charging case to charge the earbuds, as it is specifically designed for safe and efficient power delivery.



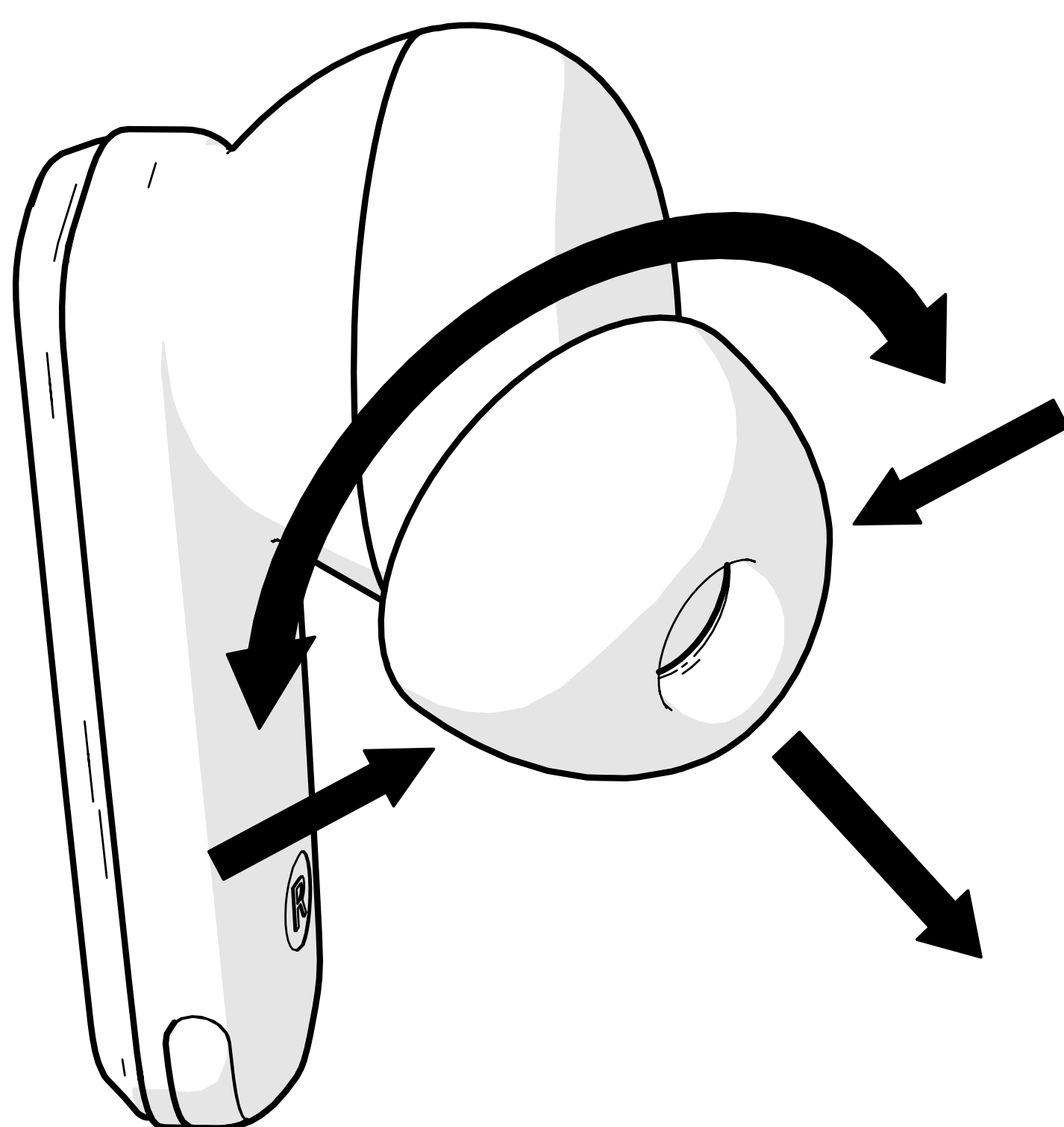
Charging Light

Fitment

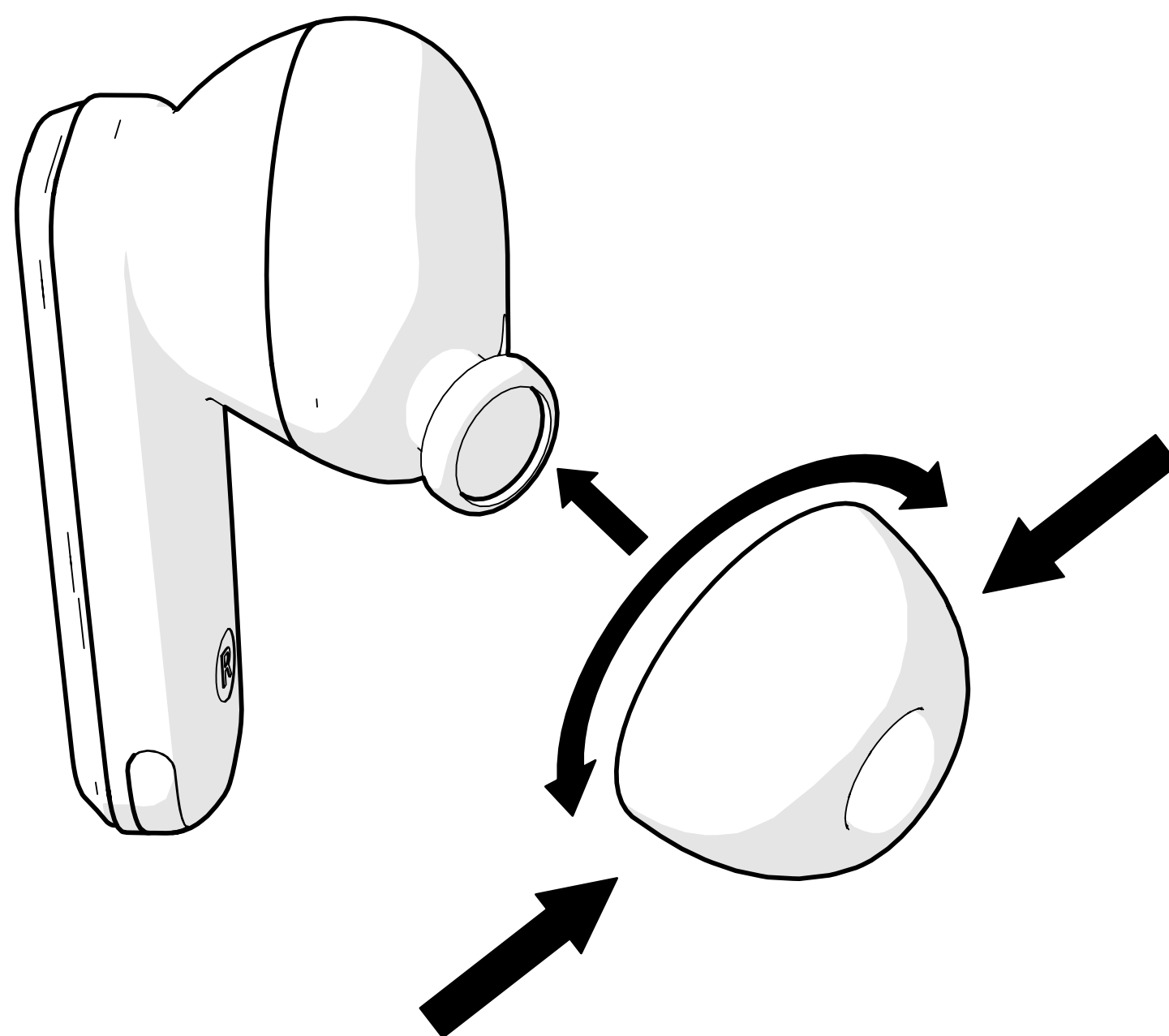
Insert earbud, and gently turn while pushing. If fitment is unsatisfactory, please try a different ear tip.



Squeeze and twist to remove tip.



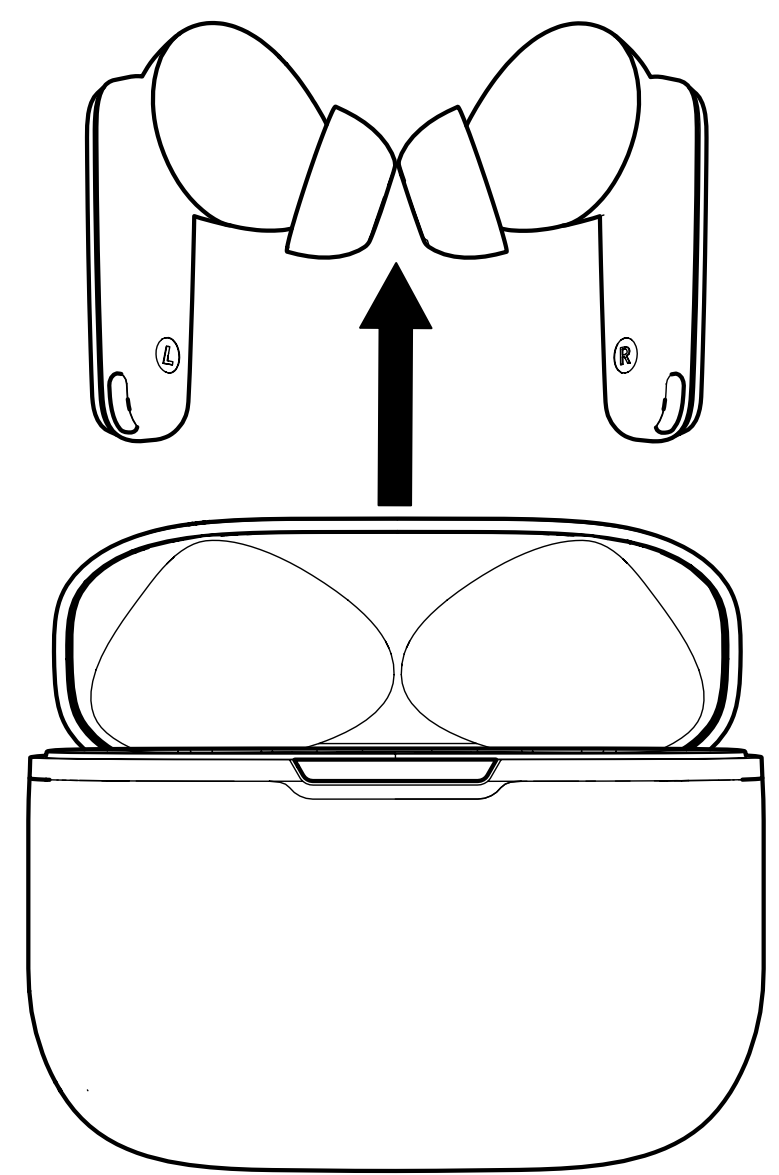
Perform the same action when replacing the tip.



Pairing and Connecting

The TWS3 earbuds support quick Bluetooth pairing for a hassle-free setup.

Initial Pairing: Open the charging case lid with the earbuds inside. The earbuds will automatically enter pairing mode, indicated by flashing white lights.



On your device, enable Bluetooth and search for “TWS3 KICKER” in the list of available devices. Select “TWS3 KICKER” to connect. A voice prompt will say “Connected” once paired.

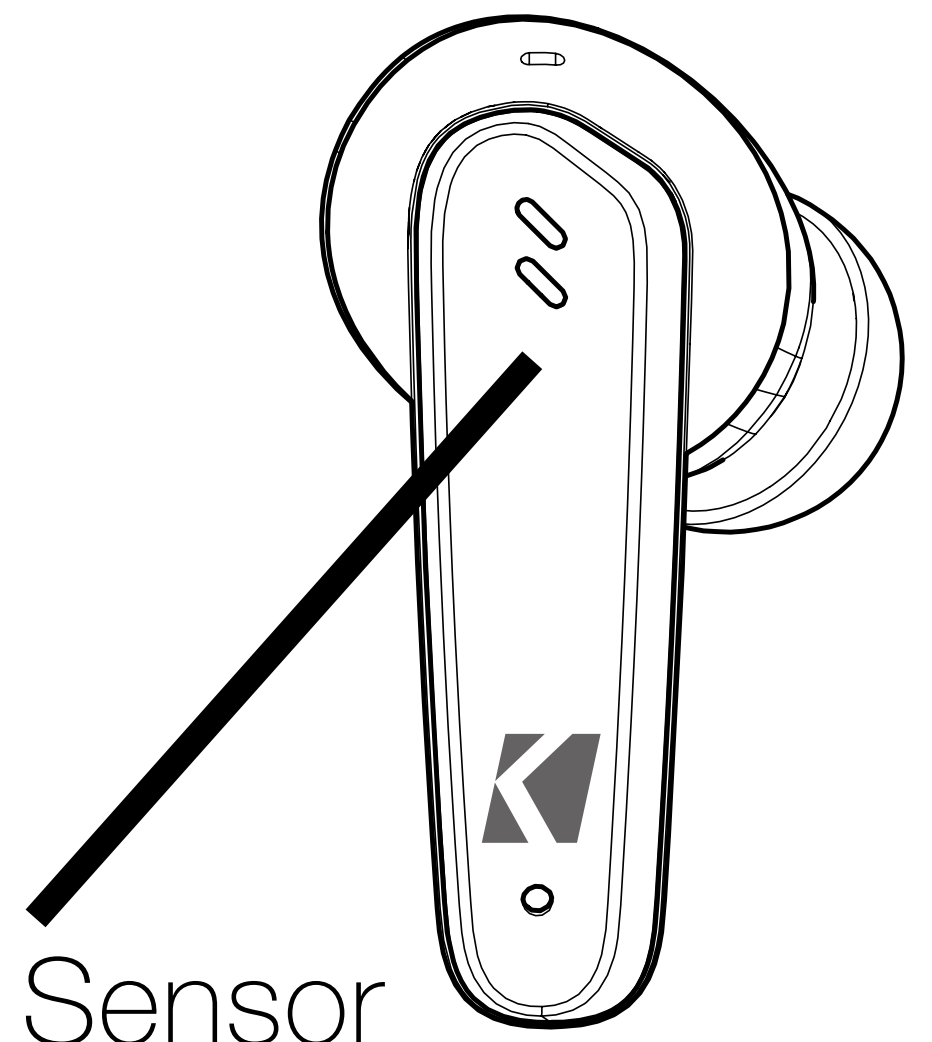
Automatic Reconnection: The earbuds will automatically reconnect to the last paired device when removed from the case. If reconnection fails, manually select “TWS3 KICKER” from your audio device’s Bluetooth menu.

Pairing with a New Device: To connect the TWS3 earbuds to a different smartphone, tablet, or computer, first disconnect them from the current one, either by removing the TWS3 from the list of paired items, disabling Bluetooth, or powering it off. Once done, the TWS3 earbuds will automatically enter pairing mode, allowing you to connect to the new audio device.

Dual Earbud Pairing: The left and right earbuds are pre-linked and function as a matched set. This pairing is locked, meaning the earbuds cannot be paired with other non-TWS3 earbuds. If you experience syncing issues, refer to the Reset section. The TWS3 supports single-earbud use. Simply remove one earbud from the case for mono audio.

Controls and Operations

The TWS3 earbuds use intuitive touch controls on the earbud stems for managing audio, calls, and modes. Controls are responsive to taps and holds.



Basic Controls

Touch Sensor

Power On/Off: Earbuds automatically power on when removed from the case and power off when placed back in (with the lid closed). The earbuds will power off automatically after 5 minutes with no Bluetooth connection.

Play/Pause Music: Double-tap either earbud.

Next Track: Long Press the right earbud.

Previous Track: Long Press the left earbud.

Answer/End Call: Double-tap either earbud during an incoming or ongoing call.

Reject Call: Long Press either earbud during an incoming call.

Voice Assistant: Triple-tap the left earbud

ANC Modes: Triple-tap the right earbud to cycle through ANC ON > ANC OFF > Transparency.

ANC Modes

Active Noise Cancellation (ANC) reduces ambient noise for focused listening. Transparency mode allows ambient sounds to pass through utilizing the microphone, ideal to maintain safety and environmental awareness of your surroundings. ANC is only available when both earbuds are in use. ANC mode is on by default. *Battery usage is higher with ANC ON; switch to OFF for extended playtime.*

Switching Modes: Triple-tap the right earbud to cycle through modes: ANC ON > ANC OFF > Transparency Mode (and repeat).

ANC ON: Blocks low-frequency noises like traffic or airplane engines, enhancing immersion in music or podcasts.

ANC OFF: Disables noise cancellation to conserve battery or when natural sound is preferred.

Transparency Mode: Amplifies external sounds through built-in microphones, allowing you to hear announcements, traffic, or conversations without removing the earbuds.

ENC: Environmental Noise Cancellation (ENC) filters out background noise during calls for clearer transmission to the recipient of your call. ENC automatically engages during calls when both earbuds are in use, suppressing wind, crowd noise, or echoes for crystal-clear voice transmission.

Resetting the Earbuds

If you encounter connectivity issues, forgotten pairings, or syncing problems, resetting clears the device's memory.

Clearing Pairing Records: Ensure the earbuds are in pairing mode (open the case lid; lights should flash white).

Press and hold the touch area on both earbuds at the same time for 6 seconds. The red and white lights will blink, confirming the reset.

This action clears all paired device information from the earbuds' memory. The internal left-right earbud link remains locked and cannot be individually paired with other devices.

Troubleshooting

TWS3 is unresponsive or will not power on:

1. Check that the battery is fully charged by connecting the TWS3 Charging Case to a known-good power source with the TWS3 earbuds inside. Allow the TWS3 to charge for at least 2.5 hours with the Case Lid closed.
2. Reset the TWS3 by pressing and holding the touch sensor for 5 seconds.

TWS3 will not pair or connect:

1. If you have previously paired your device with the TWS3, then please 'Unpair' or 'Forget this Device' per the instructions for your audio device.
2. Turn on the TWS3 earbuds with your audio device in Bluetooth Scanning mode. Make sure your audio device is scanning or in 'discovery mode', then select TWS3 KICKER.

Device paired and connected, but volume is low or inaudible:

Check the volume output level of your audio device.

No Sound:

Ensure earbuds are charged and properly paired. Check device volume.

Connection Drops:

Move closer to your device or reset Bluetooth.

One Earbud Not Working:

Place both in the case, close the lid for 10 seconds, then reopen.
